1. Students enroll in a sequence of 3 courses, based on prior experience and placement results with approval from the Head of Middle School.

2. Students in 6th Grade enroll into an additional Language Arts class (3 days/ week) and Intro to Music (2 days/ week). Students in 7th and 8th Grade take Latin (completing in two years the equivalent of the High School "Introduction to Latin" course). Spanish is available as a for-credit Elective Class during Activity Period.
